Game

Keys

Sit as a family in a circle on the floor and place some keys in the middle. Ask 1 person to close their eyes. Then another person takes the keys and hides it behind their back. The person who closed their eyes then has to guess who took the keys.

Sometimes we can tell who is coming by the reactions of other people as well as by the sounds. When Jesus came into Jerusalem everybody knew it!

Pin the tail on the donkey

Draw a picture of a donkey or Print out and cut out the attached.

Blind fold one person, spin them around and get them to try and pin the tail on the donkey

Discussion

Younger Kids

I wonder how you would have felt if you had seen Jesus enter Jerusalem?

Why do you think people were so happy to see Jesus?

I wonder how we could celebrate Jesus in our lives?

Older Kids

I wonder how you would have felt and what you would have done if you'd seen Jesus enter Jerusalem?

In the old testament God had said the saviour would enter Jerusalem on a donkey – I wonder why it was important for Jesus to do this?

Why do you think the people were so happy to see Jesus? Why do think Pharisees weren't happy?

The people thought Jesus was a King – I wonder how we can show Jesus is a King to us too?





Memory Verse and Prayer

Read Psalm 118:28

"This is the day that the LORD has made. Let us rejoice and be glad in it"

Sometimes when life is difficult, or we are feeling sad or worried it can be hard to be glad. But every day we have things to be thankful for. Why not make a list of the things you can be grateful for and say a big thank you to God for all he has provided for you and your family today?

Activities

Collage

In your garden or on your daily walk why not collect some leaves to make into a collage at home. The people in the story were so excited to welcome Jesus that they grabbed what they could find to worship Him. Then find a lolly stick and stick together.


The Road to Easter
